




## Power & Greed - A Short History Of The World

Then the author briefly surveys history's Grand Acquisitors, ranging from the Roman empress Agrippina (who manipulated her husband, the emperor Claudius, and her son, Nero, in her quest to rule) to the conquest of Latin America by Corts and Pizarro, to what he views as today's corporate exploitation of postcolonial countries.
